COMMODORE'S REPORT

Another season is over and it is congratulations to the crew of “**Fluid Building Services**”, skipper Clint Bowen and crew Anthony King and Brent Dennis, from the Manly 16ft Skiff Club on winning the NSW 16ft Skiff State Championship. Not only did they win that event but also the Australian 16ft Skiff Championship sailed at Hervey Bay, Queensland.

Those who didn't attend the Hervey Bay event missed out on a great regatta, the sailing was great and the hospitality was fantastic. I take this opportunity to congratulate the Queensland Association and, in particular, Rob Wasson, for the wonderful organisation and atmosphere that was created. The volunteers and rescue craft operators far exceeded our expectations with their enthusiasm and on water management. The social side was just so laid back and comfortable. Not only did we have great sailing, but also a fantastic holiday.

At the recently held Commodore's Meeting, we discussed ways of attracting young people back into the sport of sailing. Like their parents, the young teenagers of today are “time poor”. As soon as they are old enough they are out working in part time jobs (eg. McDonalds, etc...). The best time for teenagers to work is on the weekends and the first thing to suffer, besides mum and dad's taxi service, is their sport. One idea presented to the meeting was a possible “cadetship scheme” (or scholarship), whereby students could be paid to sail, once they reach working age to help keep them in the sport. There is quite a bit of fine tuning to be done and it may be possible to finance this from the resources of the NSW 16ft Skiff Association as I acknowledge that there are currently numerous clubs that are not in a strong financial situation to fund such an idea, without some assistance.

The 2012-13 season will see the State Championships sailed at Manly, Drummoyne and St George Clubs. With the Australian Championships to be sailed at Manly (NSW) this season and the 2013/14 at Drummoyne, the following season 2014/15 will be decided at the Australian Conference to be held during the Manly carnival. Having had some discussions with the executive of the Queensland Association, they feel that they are not in a strong enough financial position to host a Championship for several years and would prefer it to be hosted by a club like Belmont, and would even support somewhere like Salamander Bay. Sailors and NSW clubs will also need to give this some thought.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

This year has seen probably the most important change to the 16ft skiff class since the change to one design with the introduction of carbon spars. Not only has this created a challenge for everyone but is also a time of experiment and development. This change saw a mixture of boats sailing with and without the carbon rigs, with no real discernable difference, at this stage of the development.

The other major issue that the Association has continued to work on throughout the year is its survey on “Recruiting the Next Generation” which has created the opportunity for Clubs, through the Association, to share initiatives that they are undertaking to attract and maintain sailors into the 16ft skiff class. The continued review of this at both Club and Association level is imperative to ensure continued large fleets and strong competition in our class at Club regattas and State Championships.

Financially, the Association has had a reasonable year given its commitment to assisting with the running of the National Titles in Queensland (\$2,500), however, the loss for the year is expected to be turned around next year with lower travelling costs anticipated.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the NSW Champion of the 2011/2012 season, “**Fluid Building Services**” sailed by Clint Bowen, Anthony King and Brent Dennis, on a superb effort throughout the State Championship series. Congratulations to Illawarra, Georges River and Port Hunter for the conduct of their heats. I would also like to congratulate “**Fluid Building Services**” who are from the Manly Club for winning the Australian 16ft Skiff Championships in Hervey Bay Queensland in some great 11 to 20 knot south easterly conditions and weather.

The new format for the State Championships for the 13ft skiffs was used this year to accommodate sailors and study pressures around exam time for both the HSC and University by having a four heat series, with two heats back to back over two separate days. This format will continue next year with two heats before the Nationals and two heats after the Nationals. Congratulations to the 13ft skiff fleet and particularly the State Championship winner “**Bell Potter Securities**” sailed by Declan Riley and Alex McFadyen from Manly.

I would like to thank all the volunteers involved in the Association and Association events during the year for their support again, because without these people the racing and administration of the NSW 16ft Skiff movement would not occur.

Thank you to the Executive Committee for their support during the year and I look forward to working with you and any new committee members in the coming season.

SECRETARY’S REPORT

The number of skiffs registered this season again showed a decline, with registrations decreasing to 83 (2010/11 - 89), the lowest number since records became available in the mid 1940’s.

The State Championship again followed the six races at three different clubs over three weekends in late October and November.

The heats were sailed at Lake Illawarra, Port Hunter and Georges River. Each of the State Championship races attracted slightly lower numbers than in previous seasons, with around 27 starters on average, also the lowest number since open entries began nearly 30 years ago.

Association meetings continued to be held on a monthly basis during the season and were generally well attended by most clubs. Meeting venues alternated between Middle Harbour and Georges River.

Earlier last season (2010/11), the Manly Club and the NSW Association engaged a consultant to conduct a survey of the Class. The project has been titled – “Recruiting the Next Generation”, with the survey looking at many aspects of the Class now and where we have come from. Results of the survey were distributed to clubs to consider possible options that should be adopted to help promote the Class and take it forward. During this season, these suggestions were consolidated and were recently distributed to clubs to consider how they might implement some of the ideas. The Association Commodore in his report has outlined one possible initiative to be adopted by the NSW Association.

I would like to express my appreciation and thanks to Belinda Sherry who has decided to stand down as the Association's Treasurer for next season. Belinda took the job on about eight years ago with the retirement of another stalwart Association supporter, Sheena Anderson. Whilst not having sailed herself, Belinda has nonetheless given freely of her time to keep the Association's books and be part of the Executive Committee. With two young children, Belinda's time is now a bit more limited. Thanks Belinda for a job well done.

Congratulations go to Clint Bowen and the crew of "**Fluid Building Services**", Anthony King and Brent Dennis in taking out the State Championship for the second consecutive year.

I would like to thank all the officials who helped with the starting, on water supervision and administration of the Class during the year. Also my thanks to the sponsors who have helped to get the boats on the water and to regatta events. Without the support of all of these people the development of this great class and the maintaining of the 16ft Skiff Class numbers would not be possible.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act 2009* (NSW). The Committee has determined that the Association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act 2009* (NSW) and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

AASB 110 Events after the Balance Sheet Date; and
AASB 1031 Materiality.

No other applicable Accounting Standards, Australian Accounting Interpretations or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

(a) Non-Current Assets

The depreciable amount of all fixed (non-current) assets are depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the Association, commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

The carrying amounts of the Dumaresq Cup, Chas Wood Handicap Point Score Trophy, State 16ft Skiff Championship Trophy, Australian 16ft Skiff Championship Trophy and Australian 13ft Skiff Championship Trophy were all independently valued during the 2006/07 financial year. The Australian 16ft Skiff Championship Trophy and the Australian 13ft Skiff Championship Trophy are presented for events conducted by the Australian 16ft Skiff Association but are owned by the NSW 16ft Skiff Association Inc. The Australian 13ft Skiff Championship Trophy was originally donated to the Association by the Manly 16ft Skiff Sailing Club.

(b) Income Tax

As the Association is a not-for-profit sporting body, it is exempt from income tax under section 50-45 of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997*.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Once again, I would like to take this opportunity to thank most clubs for keeping their accounts up to date. This certainly made my job easier.

The Profit and Loss Statement shows that we achieved a surplus of income over expenditure this year of \$7,511. This is an increase on last year. Whilst there was a reduction in Regatta Entry Fees and Skiff Registrations, as I indicated last year, our Term Deposit interest (\$10,834) was paid in January 2012 which boosted this year's income figures. The interest was in respect of the three year term of the deposit.

The Association's financial position remains strong. It is expected that we will continue to look at ways of returning some of our surplus through prizemoney and investing in the Class' future, in particular, the 13ft skiffs. At the recent Commodore's Meeting, in response to the "Recruiting the Next Generation" initiative, there was discussion that the Association may invest some funds in a cadetship or scholarship type scheme for our younger sailors in an effort to attract them and retain them into the 16ft Skiff Class. This will need further discussion, but could be a good way of utilizing some of our surplus funds.

On behalf of the Association, I offer my thanks and appreciation to Mark Graham for again giving his time to prepare the Financial Statements for the year in an honorary capacity. This year I would again also like to especially thank Brian Treleaven, for taking on the role of honorary auditor.

This will be my last year as your Treasurer. I have decided to step down after about eight years in the job to allow me more time to concentrate on my family. Thanks to all who have been of assistance to me over the years, as I have enjoyed my time as Treasurer.
