The Association has committed to assisting financially with this project.

Financially, the Association has posted a good profit of \$2,177 due to the receipt of interest on the term deposit and reduced expenses as the Nationals were again held in Sydney at Drummoyne. This was an important event for the Drummoyne Club as it celebrated its 100 year anniversary and the National Championships were a very successful event for the Club.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the NSW State Champion for the 2013/2014 season, "*Brydens Lawyers*" (Manly) sailed by Lee Knapton, Peter Mackie and Ricky Bridge, on a superb effort throughout the State Championship series.

Congratulations to Illawarra, Belmont and Gosford Clubs for the conduct of their heats during the State Championships. This was the first year that the 16s have sailed at Gosford for many years and it was great to see them back on Brisbane Water and some great conditions.

I would also like to congratulate “*Brydens Lawyers*” for winning the Australian 16ft Skiff Championships at Drummoyne in Sydney in a mixed bag of weather conditions.

There have been some new faces in the 13ft skiff division this year and they continue to provide skippers and crew to the 16ft skiff fleet. Congratulations to the 13ft skiff fleet and particularly the State Championship winner “*Holey Dollar Rum*” sailed by Annalise Gilbert and Gus Williams from Manly.

I would like to thank all the volunteers involved in the Association and Association events during the year for their support again, because without these people the racing and administration of the NSW 16ft Skiff movement would not occur. Thank you to the Executive Committee for their support during the year and I look forward to working with you and any new committee members in the coming season.

## **SECRETARY’S REPORT**

After a small increase last season, the number of skiffs registered this season dropped by ten boats, the largest reduction for nearly ten years. There was a total of 75 boats registered (2012/13 - 85).

The State Championship again followed the six races at three different clubs over three weekends format in late October and into November. The heats were sailed at Lake Illawarra, Belmont and Gosford. Each of the State Championship races attracted an average of 28 starters.

The State Championship heats held at Gosford were the first held at that venue since 16’s stopped racing there at the end of the 1989/90 season. The Club has a good junior fleet, so we are hopeful that some future interest in 16’s was generated.

Discussions are currently underway which may see a return to a two weekend format. The number of races over that period is still be debated, with voting to take place in early August.

Association meetings continued to be held, generally on a monthly basis, during the season and were generally well attended by most clubs. Meeting venues alternated between Middle Harbour and Drummoyne. Two Skype meetings were held during the year.

Regrettably, the Georges River 16ft Sailing Club had to withdraw from the Association at the commencement of the season due to the lack of 16ft skiff boat registrations. The Club was formed in 1927 to specifically race 16ft skiffs and immediately affiliated with the Association. The Club’s halcyon years would probably be the ten year period 1967/68 to 1976/77 when the Club consistently had over 40 skiffs registered, peaking at 49 in 1970/71. Unfortunately, their numbers gradually reduced in the intervening years until last season (2012/13), when they struggled to register 3 boats. Over the years from 1927, the Club produced a number of well known State and/or Australian champion sailors – Frank Selmon, Ken Minter, Phil Singleton, Don Barnett, Alan Gray and Lee Knapton, to name just a few.

The Australian Association is actively pursuing the possibility of importing hulls from China which can hopefully be sold for around \$20,000. This should substantially reduce the cost of putting a new boat on the water, particularly if a deal can also be found to get cheaper spars and sails. The NSW Association, along with the Manly and Belmont Clubs entered into a

Memorandum of Understanding at the end of the 2013/14 season to co-fund an initial purchase of nine hulls, including the prototype. The two Clubs and Association will recover these funds through the sale of these hulls. The NSW Association's contribution will be \$30,000.

I would like to thank all the officials who helped with starting, on water supervision and administration of the Class during the year. Also my thanks to the sponsors who have helped to get the boats on the water and to regatta events. Without the support of all of these people the development of this great Class and the maintaining of the 16ft skiff Class numbers would not be possible.

**NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**  
**FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2014**

**STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

The financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act 2009* (NSW). The Committee has determined that the Association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act 2009* (NSW) and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

AASB 110 Events after the Balance Sheet Date; and  
AASB 1031 Materiality.

No other applicable Accounting Standards, Australian Accounting Interpretations or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

**(a) Non-Current Assets**

The depreciable amount of all fixed (non-current) assets are depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the Association, commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

The carrying amounts of the Dumaresq Cup, Chas Wood Handicap Point Score Trophy, State 16ft Skiff Championship Trophy, Australian 16ft Skiff Championship Trophy and Australian 13ft Skiff Championship Trophy were all independently valued during the 2006/07 financial year. The Australian 16ft Skiff Championship Trophy and the Australian 13ft Skiff Championship Trophy are presented for events conducted by the Australian 16ft Skiff Association but are owned by the NSW 16ft Skiff Association Inc. The Australian 13ft Skiff Championship Trophy was originally donated to the Association by the Manly 16ft Skiff Sailing Club.

**(b) Income Tax**

As the Association is a not-for-profit sporting body, it is exempt from income tax under section 50-45 of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997*.

**(c) Contingent Liabilities**

The Balance Sheet currently shows a carrying amount for the Chas Wood Handicap Point Score Trophy of \$5,000 based on the independent valuation received during the 2006/2007 financial year. During the 2012/2013 financial year, it came to the attention of the Executive Committee that the trophy was missing. Since this discovery continued efforts have been undertaken and are still being undertaken to locate the missing Trophy. It is noted that if the Trophy is not located, its value of \$5,000 reflected on the Balance Sheet should be written down to nil, thus impacting the balance of Non-Current Assets and Net Assets on the Balance Sheet and reducing the Net Assets of the Association to \$119,904. This matter will continue to be monitored by the Executive Committee.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**

The Profit and Loss Statement shows that we achieved a surplus of income over expenditure this year of \$2,177. This is a reduction on last year, but was expected as the Association looks at ways of returning some of the surplus funds to our sailors.

Overall, most income items were lower than last year. A reduction in Regatta Entry Fees this year was due to the fact that there were less regattas, a lower entry fee (\$30 per race, rather than \$40) and a slightly lower average number of entries in the regattas that were held.

On the expenses side, prizemoney and also trophies increased. This was principally due to an increase in prizemoney payments for the overall State Championship results, including payments back to 15<sup>th</sup> place (previously 10<sup>th</sup> place).

The Association's financial position remains strong. It is expected that we will continue to look at ways of returning some of our surplus through prizemoney and investing in the Class' future.
