The next meeting of the Association will be held at the **Georges River Club** on **Wednesday 14th April 2010** at 7.30pm. Please note the change of date from the schedule published earlier in the season. The next meeting after the 14th April will be the one scheduled on 26th May.

In the last few circulars, I notified that there are currently two **vacant positions** with the NSW 16ft Skiff Association – Assistant Secretary and Hon. Auditor. To date, I have not received any nominations for either of these positions. Both positions are ideal for someone to get involved with the Association, without too much of a time commitment.

Clubs are asked to consider whether they wish to host an **interclub Regatta event next season (2010/11)** and submit their dates to the Association by the end of this season to give other Clubs the option of framing their own club racing programmes around those dates. In accordance with the Conduct of 16ft Skiff Sailing in NSW Rules, any interclub Regatta event not submitted to the Association by 1 July will not be recognised by the Association and it will not count in any Association point scores.

The following dates have already been agreed for next season (2010/11):-

- 13th/14th November 2010 - Heats 1 and 2 - NSW State Championships at **Middle Harbour**.
- 27th/28th November 2010 - Heats 3 and 4 - NSW State Championships at **Drummoyne**.
